

## BIBLE READING LIST FOR NOVEMBER 13-19

November 13

Luke 22:39-71

John 18:1-27

Mark 15

The Lord offered the disciples the opportunity to partner with Jesus in His agony, but they choose sleep. John 18 Peter denies Christ to the servant girl. Jesus states clearly that He is the Messiah and Peter denies Him a 2nd time. Mark = Jesus sees Barabbas go free, He receives a crown of thorns while angels aren't allowed to rescue Him.

November 14

Matthew 27

Luke 23

Judas repents of his evil deeds but there was no way to undo what he has done. Judas ends his life. Pilate condemns a prisoner that he readily admits is innocent. (Luke 23:4) Pilate proves himself to be a weak leader and gives in to the people. True leadership demands making hard decisions.

November 15

John 18:28-20:31

John 18:36,37 Jesus clearly states He came to earth and was born for one purpose. He also declares His kingdom is not going to be set up on this earth. John 19 Jesus informs all who will listen that everything that has happened to Him was written down in Scripture beforehand.

November 16

Matthew 28

Mark 16

Luke 24

Jesus is resurrected from the dead. Order of events post resurrection explained. In Matt.28. Mark 16 reviews the events of the Jesus came back to life and instructs the people to go and tell everyone the good news. Luke 24 recounts the Emmaus road conversation.

November 17

John 1

Acts 1-2

John 1 teaches us Jesus was with God and had a part in the creation of the world and that He came to be born of a virgin not just a young woman. Acts 1-2 recounts the 40 days He spent teaching the disciples starting with Gods plan for future restoration of the kingdom to Israel but He does not tell them when it will be that is Father Gods secret

November 18

Acts 3-5

Acts 3-5 The apostles begin to do miracles through the power of Jesus name. Verse 26 points out **the reason for everything is "to bless you in turning away everyone of you from his iniquities.(sins) you go and tell everyone how to be saved.**

November 19

Acts 6-7

The twelve disciples are told to examine themselves and to chose 7 of the group to become the first deacons. Persecution begins with Stephen as are appointed and many are coming to Christ. Cpt 7 is Stephens defense as he is tried. - History of Israel recounted and Stephen is stoned as Paul
