<p>November 20 Acts 8-9</p>	<p>See magic like power displayed. Phillip is miraculously transported (experts estimate about 20 miles) from his dessert witnessing job to Azotus by the power of the Holy Spirit.(8: 24-40.) Paul sees God's power face to face and is blinded until he is saved. (9:4-11) Tabitha, a godly woman, known for doing good to all , is brought back to life by Peter.(9:36-42)</p>
<p>November 21 Acts 10-12</p>	<p>Locked doors open by themselves. A Roman soldier sees and talks with an angel. Salvation for everyone offered freely to Gentiles (non Jewish people) for the first time. Speaking in Tongues - means : Either people speak in a language they don't know or people hear in their own language. Here The Gentiles receive the Holy Spirit and speak in languages they don't know. God kills a king and he is eaten by worms</p>
<p>November 22 Acts 13-14</p>	<p>A false prophet tries to buy the power of the Holy Spirit and is struck blind by Gods power. The history of the Jewish nation all in one chapter Jesus declared to be the Son of God completed every prophecy concerning the Messiah.(13:29) The prince of Jupiter wants to worship Paul. An argument erupts because Gentiles are equal with Jews in having the Holy Spirit.</p>
<p>November 23 James 1-5</p>	<p>Trials are for your good. God promises wisdom. 1:5 If you break one rule you are guilty of breaking all of them. Cpt 2 Your tongue is a danger to yourself and others. Cpt 3 shows how you can make the Devil run away. Cpt. 4:7 Dangers of having money (riches). Your faith and consistent prayaer can heal the sick. Cpt 5:15</p>
<p>November 24 Acts 15:1-35 Galatians 1-2</p>	<p>Salvation does not require works of any kind. Everyone can go to heaven. Acts 15:7-11. God will curse anyone who teaches differently than the Bible teaches. Gal 1:6-13. Paul's story of how Christ changed Paul from persecuting Christians to becoming one. Gal 1:11-16. The persecutor became the persecuted and gave his life for Christ.</p>
<p>November 25 Galatians 3-6 Acts 15:36-41</p>	<p>Acts 15:37-41= Why did God give us rules if we can't keep them? The law has a reason. Gal 3:24. Make your life stand out for Christ=. Gal 5:1. Acts 15:37-41= Two Christians fight about giving someone who messed up another chance and go their separate ways for now, later they reconcile and give the offender another chance in Acts 15:37-41 but II Tim 4:11 gives us the reconciliation and restoration to fellowship.</p>
<p>November 26 Acts 16:1-18:11</p>	<p>Cpt 16 =Paul is falsely accused, beaten, thrown into jail with feet locked in stocks; but because he loves Jesus so much he can't stop singing Gods praises. An angel appears & opens doors without a key. Paul; won't run away = knows jailer would be killed if he escapes. The jailer was led to the Lord by the prisoner and is baptized. The government is forced to set them free because Paul was a Roman citizen. . 17:11 a church is praised for searching the Bible daily and studying it in depth to see if what they were being taught was true. We also should be searching the Bible daily.</p>
