

BIBLE READING LIST FOR NOVEMBER 6-12

November 6

Mark 12

Luke 20

Christ showed in parables, that he **would** be the stone(the Messiah) which the builders rejected., and is become the head of the corner: by "the stone" meant the same with the son and heir in the parable, even himself, the true Messiah; who "the builders" will reject.

November 7

Matthew 22-23

Luke 21

What does Jesus expect of us - Every part of our lives. In order to do this Jesus points out our failures come from our lack of knowledge and from our lack of Bible study in Matt. 22. Luke points out what the world will be like before He returns. It reads like today's news reports.

November 8

Mark 13

Matthew 24

Mark 13 stresses the value of knowing the scriptures and not being deceived by what is happening in our world today and warnings for each of us to be prepared. **Jesus could come today.** Matthew continues with a description of the rapture when He comes and takes all true believers to be with Him.

November 9

Matthew 25:1-26:20

Mark 14:1-17

Matthew 25 warns us **not to believe anyone who says they know when Jesus will return** followed by an encouragement concerning rewards available for faithfully serving Him. Jesus also warns of coming judgment and no second chance if we fail to recognize His leading.

November 10

Mark 14:18-25

Matthew 26:21-29

The Passover meal is given new meaning as atonement for His death. Peter vows forever loyalty. Jesus tells him he will deny him yet tonight. Judas sells out Jesus for money. Mark stresses Jesus foreknowledge of the cross followed by total yieldedness to the Father's will. Matt. and John mention Jesus washing the disciples feet.

November 11

John 15-17

John brings out our utter dependence on Jesus using the illustration of the vine sustaining the branches and the helplessness of the branch to function without the vine. He also stresses the importance of obedience and love.

November 12

Matthew 26:30-75

Mark 14:26-72

Mark describes Jesus struggle in the Mount of Olives and the disciples sleeping through it. Jesus is betrayed by Judas and explains to the disciples his ability to call the angels to stop the crucifixion. Mark points out Jesus clear statement that He is the Christ the Son of the Blessed (God).
